# Public Health (Meat) Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

I, JAMES JOSEPH CARLTON, the Minister of State for Health, hereby make the following Regulations under the Public Health Ordinance 1928.

#### Interpretation

1. Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Meat) Regulations is amended by inserting after the definition of "Butcher's shop" the following definition:

"'Chairman' means the person for the time being holding, or performing the duties of, the office of Chairman of the Capital Territory Health Commission:".

### **Meat Vendor's licence**

2. Regulation 4 of the Public Health (Meat) Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting "accompanied by a fee of \$20, grant to him" and substituting "and upon payment to the Capital Territory Health Commission of a fee of \$20, grant to the person";
- (b) by inserting "to the Capital Territory Health Commission" after "upon payment"; and
- (c) by omitting "the fee of \$20 shall be refunded to the applicant" and substituting "the applicant shall be entitled to be refunded the fee of \$20 paid by him".

### Permit to sell prepared meat goods

3. Regulation 6 of the Public Health (Meat) Regulations is amended—

- (a) by inserting "to the Capital Territory Health Commission" after "pay-. ment": and
- (b) by omitting "him" and substituting "the person".
