Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations² (Amendment)

Premium rates

1. Regulation 16 of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (2) "\$180" and substituting "\$206".
