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Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Ombudsman Regulations.¹

Interpretation

- 1A. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—
“the Act” means the *Ombudsman Act 1989*.

Certain persons not to be prescribed authorities

2. A person holding or performing the duties of an office specified in Schedule 1 is not a prescribed authority for the purposes of the Act.

Prescribed authorities

2A. Pursuant to paragraph (b) of the definition of “prescribed authority” in subsection 3 (1) of the Act, a body specified in Schedule 1A is declared to be a prescribed authority for the purposes of the Act.

Principal offices

3. For the purposes of the definition of “principal officer” in section 3 of the Act, an office specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 is declared to be a principal office in respect of the prescribed authority specified in column 1 of that Schedule opposite to that office.
