Commencement

1. These Regulations commence on the day on which section 16 of the *Stock Diseases (Amendment) Act 1991* commences.

Insertion

2. After regulation 3 of the Stock Diseases Regulations the following regulation is inserted:

Prescribed law defined

“3A. For the purposes of subsection 11A (2) of the Act, ‘prescribed law’ means each of the following as amended and in force from time to time:

- (a) the Stock Diseases Act, 1923 of the State of New South Wales;
- (b) the Stock Diseases Act, 1968 of the State of Victoria;
- (c) the Stock Act, 1990 of the State of South Australia;
- (d) the Stock Act 1915 of the State of Queensland;
- (e) the Stock Diseases Act of the Northern Territory;
- (f) the Stock (Brands and Movement) Act 1984 of the State of Tasmania;
- (g) the Stock (Brands and Movement) Act, 1970 of the State of Western Australia;
- (h) the Stock Diseases (Regulations) Act, 1968 of the State of Western Australia;
- (i) any regulations made under any of the abovementioned Acts.”.
