

## Water Pollution Regulations<sup>1</sup> (Amendment)

Subordinate Law No. 31 of 1992<sup>2</sup>

## **Principal Regulations**

1. In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Water Pollution Regulations.

#### Commencement

**2.** These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

## Interpretation

- **3.** Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is amended—
- (a) by omitting from paragraphs (2) (a), (b) and (c) "Column 1 of";
- **(b)** by omitting from paragraphs (2) (a), (b) and (c) "column" and substituting "Schedule"; and
- (c) by omitting from paragraph (2) (c) "4" and substituting "3".

### Discharge into Class P waters

- **4.** Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations is amended—
- (a) by omitting from subregulation (5) all words from and including "unless—" and substituting the following:
  - "unless the waste has been treated according to a method of disinfection which the Authority, by notice in the *Gazette*, declares to be acceptable."; and
- **(b)** by omitting subregulation (7).

## Discharge into Class C waters

**5.** Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting subregulations (2), (3), (5) and (7) to (13) (inclusive).

## Discharge into Class R waters

**6.** Regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting subregulations (2), (3), (4), (6) and (8) to (13) (inclusive).

## Discharge into Class O waters

**7.** Regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting subregulations (2), (5) and (6).

#### Discharge into Class U waters

**8.** Regulation 12 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting subregulations (2) and (3).

## **Repeal of Part**

**9.** Part IV of the Principal Regulations is repealed.

## **Schedules**

**10.** Schedules 1, 2 and 4 to the Principal Regulations are repealed and the following Schedules substituted:
