Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Supreme Court (Remuneration and Allowances) Regulations.

Commencement

2. These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

Remuneration and allowances

3. (1) An acting Judge is entitled to remuneration at the rate of \$1,500 per day for each day on which he or she performs the duties, or exercises the powers, of a Judge.

(2) An acting Judge is entitled to an allowance of \$300 for each night on which he or she is absent from his or her usual place of residence in connection with the performance of the duties, or the exercise of the powers, of a Judge.
