

Liquor Regulations¹ (Amendment)

Subordinate Law No. 41 of 1997²

The Australian Capital Territory Executive makes the following Regulations under the *Liquor Act 1975*.

Commencement

1. These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Regulations

2. In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Liquor Regulations.

Prescribed times for sale or supply of liquor

- 3. (1) Section 3A of the Principal Regulations is amended—
- (a) by omitting from subparagraph (3) (a) (i) all the words after "between" (first occurring) and substituting "5 a.m. and 8 a.m. on that day; or";
- (b) by omitting from subparagraph (3) (a) (ii) all the words after "between" (first occurring) and substituting "4 a.m. and 7 a.m. on that day; or"; and
- (c) by omitting from paragraph (3) (b) all the words after "between" and substituting "midnight and 8 a.m. and between 11 p.m. and midnight on any day".
- (2) On 1 January 1998 the Principal Regulations have effect as if regulation 3A had been amended—
 - (a) by omitting from paragraph (1) (a) "5 a.m." and substituting "6 a.m.";
 - **(b)** by omitting from paragraph (1) (b) "4 a.m." and substituting "6 a.m.";
 - (c) by omitting from subparagraph (3) (a) (i) "5 a.m." and substituting "6 a.m."; and
 - (d) by omitting from subparagraph (3) (a) (ii) "4 a.m." and substituting "6 a.m.".
