#### Commencement

**1.** These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

## **Principal Regulations**

**2.** In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Motor Traffic Regulations.

#### Schedule

**3.** The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting before item 1 of Part I the following items:

1A	Section 150G	Parking, on residential land, a stock 112 truck or semi-trailer, or a vehicle whether loaded or unloaded, that—
		(i) exceeds 3.6 metres in height; and
		(ii) is used for commercial purpose <b>s</b>
1B	Section 150H	Parking a heavy vehicle on land 62 adjoining residential land for a period exceeding 1 hour
1C	Section 150J	Parking, on residential land 112 containing a multi-unit development, a commercial vehicle (whether loaded or unloaded) that—
		(a) exceeds 6 metres in length;
		(b) exceeds 2.6 metres in height; or
		(c) has a GVM exceeding 3.75 tonnes
