Commencement

1. These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Regulations

2. In these Regulations, “Principal Regulations” means the Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) (Solicitors’ Costs) Regulations.

Costs of ordinary claims—application of Supreme Court Rules

3. Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from paragraph (1) (a) “the amount referred to in Order 4, paragraph 6 (3) (a)” and substituting “the prescribed costs are the amount referred to in Order 3, paragraph 2 (a)”.

Costs of special claims—application of Supreme Court Rules

4. Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) “Order 4, paragraph 6 (3) (a)” and substituting “Order 3, paragraph 2 (a)”; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) “Order 4, subrule 6 (4)” and substituting “Order 3, subrule 3 (2)”.
