2 Principal Regulations

In these regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the *Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations*.

3 Citation

Regulation 1 of the Principal Regulations is amended by adding at the end "1947".

4 Premium rates

Regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from subregulation (2) "\$133.50" and substituting "\$107.50".

5 Schedule 1

Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting Part 2 and substituting the following Part:
