

# Smoke-free Areas (Enclosed Public Places) Regulations Amendment

Subordinate Law 2000 No 30

The Australian Capital Territory Executive makes the following regulations under the *Smoke-free Areas (Enclosed Public Places) Act 1994*.

#### 1 Commencement

These regulations commence at the expiration of 90 days after the day they are notified in the Gazette.

## 2 Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Smoke-free Areas* (Enclosed Public Places) Regulations.

#### 3 Substitution

Regulations 1 and 2 are repealed and the following regulation substituted:

## "1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the Smoke-free Areas (Enclosed Public Places) Regulations 1994.".

#### 4 Addition

The regulations are amended by adding at the end the following regulation and Schedule:

## "6 Prescribed places where smoking allowed

For paragraph 5 (4) (b) of the Act, a place mentioned in Schedule 1 is prescribed in the circumstances mentioned in the Schedule for the place.
