

Road Transport (Dimensions and Mass) Regulations 2000

1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the Road Transport (Dimensions and Mass) Regulations 2000.

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the commencement of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*.

3 Definitions

In these regulations, the following definition applies: *the Act* means the *Road Transport (Dimensions and Mass) Act 1990*.

4 Authorised person to have unique number

- (1) The road transport authority must give a unique number to each person who is an authorised person for subsection 43 (1) of the Act.
- (2) This regulation does not apply to a person who is given a unique number under regulation 11 (Persons authorised for infringement notices etc to have unique number) of the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulations* 2000.

5 Identifying particulars for police officer or authorised person

- (1) For subparagraph 43 (4) (b) (iv) of the Act, the identifying particular for a police officer is the service number of the police officer.
- (2) For subparagraph 43 (4) (b) (iv) of the Act, the identifying particular for an authorised person is the unique number given to the authorised person—
 - (a) by the road transport authority under regulation 4; or
 - (b) under regulation 11 (Persons authorised for infringement notices etc to have unique number) of the *Road Transport (Offences)* Regulations 2000.
