1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Road Transport (Dimensions and Mass) Regulations 2000*.

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the commencement of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*.

3 Definitions

In these regulations, the following definition applies:

the Act means the *Road Transport (Dimensions and Mass) Act 1990*.

4 Authorised person to have unique number

(1) The road transport authority must give a unique number to each person who is an authorised person for subsection 43 (1) of the Act.

(2) This regulation does not apply to a person who is given a unique number under regulation 11 (Persons authorised for infringement notices etc to have unique number) of the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2000*.

5 Identifying particulars for police officer or authorised person

(1) For subparagraph 43 (4) (b) (iv) of the Act, the identifying particular for a police officer is the service number of the police officer.

(2) For subparagraph 43 (4) (b) (iv) of the Act, the identifying particular for an authorised person is the unique number given to the authorised person—

- (a) by the road transport authority under regulation 4; or
- (b) under regulation 11 (Persons authorised for infringement notices etc to have unique number) of the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2000*.
