#### 1 Commencement

- (1) These regulations (other than regulation 4) commence on the day they are notified in the Gazette.
- (2) Regulation 4 commences on the commencement of regulation 3 of these regulations or the commencement of the *Legislation Act 2001*, section 18 (ACT legislation register), whichever is later.
