# Building and Construction Industry Training Levy Regulations 2001

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**1 Name of regulations**

These regulations are the *Building and Construction Industry Training Levy Regulations 2001*.

**2 Commencement**

These regulations commence on their notification day.

**3 Who is a qualified valuer?**

- (1) A qualified valuer is a person who is—
- (a) an accredited valuer; or
  - (b) an architect registered under the *Architects Act 1959* or a corresponding State law; or
  - (c) an engineer who is registered on the National Professional Engineers Register administered by The Institution of Engineers, Australia in any of the following general areas of practice:
    - (i) building services;
    - (ii) civil;
    - (iii) electrical;
    - (iv) structural; or
  - (d) a quantity surveyor who is a corporate member of The Australian Institute of Quantity Surveyors.

(2) In this regulation:

*accredited valuer* means a person who is—

- (a) registered, licensed or approved under a Commonwealth or State law to carry out valuations of property; or
- (b) accredited as a certified practising valuer by the Australian Property Institute Incorporated.
