1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Crimes (Forensic Procedures) Amendment Regulations 2003 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day after their notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Crimes (Forensic Procedures) Regulations 2000*.
