1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the Utilities (Water Restrictions) Amendment Regulations 2003 (No 1).

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day after their notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Utilities (Water Restrictions)* Regulations 2002.

4 Regulation 6 (1) (c)

substitute

- (c) the imposition of each stage of water restrictions by reference to 1 or more of the following:
 - (i) the capacity or quality of stored water available to the utility for water services;
 - (ii) any reduction in water consumption to be achieved.
