## 1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Workers Compensation Amendment Regulations 2004 (No 1)*.

## 2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day after their notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
