1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Road Transport (Offences) Amendment Regulations 2004 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day after their notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

These regulations amend the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2001*.

4 New regulation 14A

14A Delegation of administering authority's functions—Act, s 54 (1) (b)

The administering authority for an infringement notice offence may delegate the authority's functions to a public employee.
