1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Magistrates Court (Fisheries Infringement Notices) Regulations 2004.*

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day after their notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Purpose of regulations

The purpose of these regulations is to provide for infringement notices under the *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, part 8 for certain offences against the fisheries legislation.

Note

The *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, pt 8 provides a system of infringement notices for offences against various Acts. The infringement notice system is intended to provide an alternative to prosecution.

4 Notes

A note included in these regulations is explanatory and is not part of these regulations.

Note See Legislation Act, s 127 (1), (4) and (5) for the legal status of notes.

5 Meaning of fisheries legislation

In these regulations:

fisheries legislation means—

- (a) the Fisheries Act 2000; and
- (b) the Fisheries Regulations 2001.

6 Administering authority

The administering authority for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation is the conservator of flora and fauna.

7 Infringement notice offences

The *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, part 8 applies to an offence against a provision of the fisheries legislation mentioned in schedule 1, column 2.

8 Infringement notice penalties

- (1) The penalty payable by an individual for an offence against the fisheries legislation, under an infringement notice for the offence, is the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 4 for the offence.
- (2) The penalty payable by a corporation for an offence against the fisheries legislation, under an infringement notice for the offence, is 5 times the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 4 for the offence.
- (3) The cost of serving a reminder notice for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation is \$34.

9 Contents of infringement notices—other information

(1) An infringement notice served on a company by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation must include the company's ACN.

Note The requirement under this regulation is additional to the requirement under the Magistrates Court Act 1930, s 121 (1) (c).

(2) In this regulation:

company means a company registered under the Corporations Act.

10 Contents of infringement notices—identifying authorised person

An infringement notice served on a person by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation must identify the authorised person by—

- (a) the authorised person's full name, or surname and initials; or
- (b) any unique number given to the authorised person by the administering authority under regulation 6 (Administering authority) for these regulations.

11 Contents of reminder notices—identifying authorised person

A reminder notice served on a person by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation must identify the authorised person by—

- (a) the authorised person's full name, or surname and initials; or
- (b) any unique number given to the authorised person by the administering authority under regulation 6 (Administering authority) for these regulations.

12 Authorised people for infringement notice offences

A conservation officer under the *Nature Conservation Act 1980*, section 8 may serve—

- (a) an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation; and
- (b) a reminder notice for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation.
