2	Commencement
	This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

3	Legislation amended
	This regulation amends the Construction Occupations (Licensing) Regulation 2004.

52 Modification of Act, s 149—Act, s 152

- (1) The Act, section 149 is modified by omitting paragraph (d) and substituting the following paragraphs:
 - (d) the Energy and Water Act 1988; or
 - (e) the Gas Act 1992; or
 - (f) the Plumbers, Drainers and Gasfitters Board Act 1982.
 - *Note* A reference to an Act includes a reference to the statutory instruments made or in force under the Act, including any regulation (see Legislation Act, s 104).
- (2) This section expires on 1 September 2005.
