About this republication

The republished law

This is a republication of the *Financial Management Regulation 2005*, made under the *Financial Management Act 1996* (including any amendment made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 (Editorial changes)) as in force on 1 January 2006. It also includes any commencement, repeal or expiry affecting the republished law.

The legislation history and amendment history of the republished law are set out in endnotes 3 and 4.

Kinds of republications

The Parliamentary Counsel's Office prepares 2 kinds of republications of ACT laws (see the ACT legislation register at www.legislation.act.gov.au):

- authorised republications to which the *Legislation Act 2001* applies
- unauthorised republications.

The status of this republication appears on the bottom of each page.

Editorial amendments

The *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 authorises the Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial amendments and other changes of a formal nature when preparing a law for republication. Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 115 and s 117). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

This republication does not include amendments made under part 11.3 (see endnote 1).

Uncommenced provisions and amendments

If a provision of the republished law has not commenced or is affected by an uncommenced amendment, the symbol **U** appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the uncommenced provision or amendment appears only in the last endnote.

Modifications

If a provision of the republished law is affected by a current modification, the symbol **M** appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the modifying provision appears in the endnotes. For the legal status of modifications, see *Legislation Act 2001*, section 95.

Penalties

The value of a penalty unit for an offence against this republished law at the republication date is—

- (a) if the person charged is an individual—\$100; or
- (b) if the person charged is a corporation—\$500.

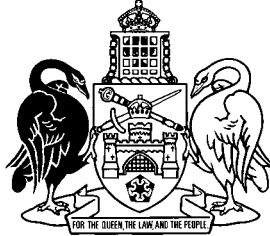

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Financial Management Regulation 2005*.

[1.1] New sections 110A and 110B

insert

110A Application of Legislation Act, s 94 to certain appointments, elections and approvals

- (1) This section applies to the following:
 - (a) an appointment in force immediately before 1 January 2006 under an amended Act;
 - (b) the election of a person elected to office if the person held the office immediately before 1 January 2006 under an amended Act;
 - (c) an approval by a Minister of a territory authority taking part in a kind of joint venture under an amended Act if the approval was in force immediately before 1 January 2006.
- (2) The Legislation Act, section 94 applies to the appointment, election or approval as if—
 - (a) the Legislation Act, section 94 (4), definition of *amend* read as follows:

amend includes omit and re-enact in the same or another law (with or without changes); and
 - (b) for an election—a reference in this Act to a person being appointed to an office were taken to include a reference to the person being elected to the office.

- (3) In this section:

amended Act means an Act amended by the *Financial Management Legislation Amendment Act 2005*.

- (4) This section expires on 27 October 2007.

110B Application of Act to Health Promotion Act

- (1) This Act applies to the *Health Promotion Act 1995* as if that Act required the chief executive officer of the health promotion authority to be a public servant.
- (2) This section expires on 27 October 2007.
