1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Public Health Amendment Regulation 2006 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
