**1 Name of regulation**

This regulation is the *Occupational Health and Safety (General) Amendment Regulation 2008 (No 1)*.

**2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

**3 Legislation amended**

This regulation amends the *Occupational Health and Safety (General) Regulation 2007*.

*Note* This regulation also amends the *Magistrates Court (Occupational Health and Safety Infringement Notices) Regulation 2004* (see s 10 and s 11).

**85 Employer to protect site of dangerous occurrence**

**9 Section 85 (1)**

*substitute*

- (1) This section applies if an employer is required to give the chief executive notice of a dangerous occurrence under the Act, section 204 (1) (d).
- (1A) The employer must ensure that the site where the dangerous occurrence happened is not entered or otherwise disturbed—
  - (a) for 72 hours; or
  - (b) until an inspector directs otherwise.

Maximum penalty: 10 penalty units.
