1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Firearms Amendment Regulation 2009 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Firearms Regulation 2008*.

in part 15, insert

73A People exempt from Act—Act, s 272 (2) (r)

A member of a police service or force of a foreign country is exempt from the Act in relation to a firearm the member possesses or uses if the possession or use is for taking part in a training activity—

- (a) conducted by the Australian Federal Police; and
- (b) carried out in the ACT.
