### 4 Drugs of dependence—Act, dict, def drug of dependence

Each of the following substances is a *drug of dependence* for the Act:

- (a) a substance mentioned in the *Criminal Code Regulation 2005*, schedule 1 (Controlled drugs), part 1.1 (Controlled medicines);
- (b) an associated drug (within the meaning of that regulation, section 5 (2)) of a substance mentioned in that part;
- (c) a related drug (within the meaning of that regulation, section 5 (3)) of a substance mentioned in that part.

# 5 Prohibited substances—Act, dict, def *prohibited substance*

Each of the following substances is a *prohibited substance* for the Act:

- (a) a substance mentioned in the *Criminal Code Regulation 2005*, schedule 1 (Controlled drugs), part 1.2 (Prohibited substances);
- (b) an associated drug (within the meaning of that regulation, section 5 (2)) of a substance mentioned in that part;
- (c) a related drug (within the meaning of that regulation, section 5 (3)) of a substance mentioned in that part.

#### 6 Legislation repealed

The Drugs of Dependence Regulation 2005 (SL2005-3) is repealed.
