1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Amendment Regulation 2009 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the commencement of the *Civil Partnerships Amendment Act 2009 (No 2)*.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

 - (iii) the civil partnership notary's full name; and
 - (iv) details of the notary's registration as a civil partnership notary under that Act, part 2A; and
 - (v) the date and place of registration under that Act, section 8BA;
