1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Amendment Regulation 2010 (No 3).*

2 Commencement

(1) This regulation (other than schedule 1) commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

(2) Schedule 1 commences on the commencement of the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (ACT) Act 2010*, section 3.
