1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Crimes (Sentencing) Amendment Regulation 2010 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Crimes (Sentencing) Regulation 2006*.

**1A Offence in relation to which victim may make statement—
Act, s 48 (b)**

The Act, part 4.3 (Victim impact statements) applies to a contravention of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999*, section 6 (Negligent driving) if the driving occasions grievous bodily harm.
