Magistrates Court (Plastic Shopping Bags Ban Infringement Notices) Regulation 2011

SL2011-19

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Magistrates Court (Plastic Shopping Bags Ban Infringement Notices) Regulation 2011.

2 Commencement

- (1) This regulation (other than schedule 1, item 1) commences on 1 July 2011.
 - *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
- (2) Schedule 1, item 1 commences on 1 November 2011.

3 Dictionary

The dictionary at the end of this regulation is part of this regulation.

- *Note 1* The dictionary at the end of this regulation defines certain terms used in this regulation.
- *Note* 2 A definition in the dictionary applies to the entire regulation unless the definition, or another provision of the regulation, provides otherwise or the contrary intention otherwise appears (see Legislation Act, s 155 and s 156 (1)).

4 Notes

A note included in this regulation is explanatory and is not part of this regulation.

Note See the Legislation Act, s 127 (1), (4) and (5) for the legal status of notes.

5 Purpose of regulation

The purpose of this regulation is to provide for infringement notices under the *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, part 3.8 for certain offences against the Plastic Bags Ban Act.

Note The *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, pt 3.8 provides a system of infringement notices for offences against various Acts. The infringement notice system is intended to provide an alternative to prosecution.

6 Administering authority

The administering authority for an infringement notice offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act is the commissioner for fair trading.

7 Infringement notice offences

The *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, part 3.8 applies to an offence against a provision of the Plastic Bags Ban Act mentioned in schedule 1, column 2.

8 Infringement notice penalties

- (1) The penalty payable by an individual for an offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act, under an infringement notice for the offence, is the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 4 for the offence.
- (2) The penalty payable by a corporation for an offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act, under an infringement notice for the offence, is 3.5 times the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 4 for the offence.
- (3) The cost of serving a reminder notice for an infringement notice offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act is \$34.

9 Contents of infringement notices—identifying authorised person

An infringement notice served on a person by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act must identify the authorised person by—

- (a) the authorised person's full name, or surname and initials; or
- (b) any unique number given, for this regulation, to the authorised person by the administering authority.

10 Contents of infringement notices—other information

- (1) An infringement notice served on a company by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act must include the company's ACN.
 - *Note* The requirement under this section is additional to the requirement under the *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, s 121 (1) (c).
- (2) In this section:

company means a company registered under the Corporations Act.

11 Contents of reminder notices—identifying authorised person

A reminder notice served on a person by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act must identify the authorised person by—

- (a) the authorised person's full name, or surname and initials; or
- (b) any unique number given, for this regulation, to the authorised person by the administering authority.

12 Authorised people for infringement notice offences

An investigator may serve—

- (a) an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act; and
- (b) a reminder notice for an infringement notice offence against the Plastic Bags Ban Act.

13 Expiry

Schedule 1, items 2 and 3, and this section, expire on 1 November 2011.
