1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Government Procurement Amendment Regulation 2012 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the commencement of the *Government Procurement Amendment Act 2012*, section 4.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Government Procurement Regulation 2007*.

4 Section 10 (2), new examples 5 and 6

insert

- 5 where a secondary objective of the procurement is to achieve an appreciable social or community benefit
- 6 the procurement is through a common use agreement established in another jurisdiction.

5 New sections 12A and 12B

insert

12A Notifiable contract threshold—Act, s 25 (2) (a)

The prescribed amount is \$25 000.

12B Notifiable amendment threshold—Act, s 26 (a) (ii)

The prescribed amount is \$25 000.
