This regulation is the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Amendment Regulation 2014 (No 1).*

2 Commencement

Note

(1) This regulation (other than section 11) commences on the day after this regulation's notification day.

The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

(2) Section 11 commences on 1 October 2014.
