1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Magistrates Court (Animal Welfare Infringement Notices) Regulation 2014.

2 Commencement

(1) This regulation (other than schedule 1, items 2 to 4) commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

- (2) Schedule 1, items 2 to 4 commence on the later of—
 - (a) the commencement of the *Animal Welfare (Factory Farming) Amendment Act 2014*, section 3; and
 - (b) the day after this regulation's notification day.

3 Dictionary

The dictionary at the end of this regulation is part of this regulation.

- Note 1 The dictionary at the end of this regulation defines certain terms used in this regulation, and includes references (*signpost definitions*) to other terms defined elsewhere.
 - For example, the signpost definition 'authorised officer—see the *Animal Welfare Act 1992*, dictionary.' means that the term 'authorised officer' is defined in that dictionary and the definition applies to this regulation.
- Note 2 A definition in the dictionary (including a signpost definition) applies to the entire regulation unless the definition, or another provision of the regulation, provides otherwise or the contrary intention otherwise appears (see Legislation Act, s 155 and s 156 (1)).

4 Notes

A note included in this regulation is explanatory and is not part of this regulation.

Note See the Legislation Act, s 127 (1), (4) and (5) for the legal status of notes.

5 Purpose of regulation

The purpose of this regulation is to provide for infringement notices under the *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, part 3.8 for certain offences against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992*.

Note The Magistrates Court Act 1930, pt 3.8 provides a system of infringement notices for offences against various Acts. The infringement notice system is intended to provide an alternative to prosecution.

6 Administering authority

The administering authority for an infringement notice offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992* is the Animal Welfare Authority.

7 Infringement notice offences

The *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, part 3.8 applies to an offence against a provision of the *Animal Welfare Act 1992* mentioned in schedule 1, column 2.

8 Infringement notice penalties

(1) The penalty payable by an individual for an offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992*, under an infringement notice for the offence, is the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 4 for the offence.

- (2) The penalty payable by a corporation for an offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992*, under an infringement notice for the offence, is 5 times the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 4 for the offence.
- (3) The cost of serving a reminder notice for an infringement notice offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992* is \$34.

9 Contents of infringement notices—identifying authorised person

An infringement notice served on a person by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992* must identify the authorised person by—

- (a) the authorised person's full name, or surname and initials; or
- (b) any unique number given, for this regulation, to the authorised person by the administering authority.

10 Contents of infringement notices—other information

(1) An infringement notice served on a company by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992* must include the company's ACN.

Note The requirement under this section is additional to the requirement under the *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, s 121 (1) (c).

(2) In this section:

company means a company registered under the Corporations Act.

11 Contents of reminder notices—identifying authorised person

A reminder notice served on a person by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992* must identify the authorised person by—

- (a) the authorised person's full name, or surname and initials; or
- (b) any unique number given, for this regulation, to the authorised person by the administering authority.

12 Authorised people for infringement notice offences

An inspector or authorised officer may serve—

- (a) an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992*; or
- (b) a reminder notice for an infringement notice offence against the *Animal Welfare Act 1992*.

 - administering authority
 - authorised person
 - infringement notice
 - infringement notice offence
 - reminder notice.

Animal Welfare Authority means the Animal Welfare Authority established under the Animal Welfare Act 1992, section 5.

authorised officer—see the Animal Welfare Act 1992, dictionary.

inspector—see the Animal Welfare Act 1992, dictionary.
