#### 1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Gaming Machine Amendment Regulation 2014 (No 2).

#### 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

#### 3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the Gaming Machine Regulation 2004.

#### 4 Section 75

### 75 Offence to operate high-denomination note acceptor—Act, s 178 (2) (a)

(1) A licensee commits an offence if the licensee operates a note acceptor that accepts bank notes in denominations of \$100.

Maximum penalty: 5 penalty units.

(2) An offence against subsection (1) is a strict liability offence.
