1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Road Transport (Offences) Amendment Regulation 2015 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2005*.

4 Section 21 (2) (a)

substitute

- (a) double the number of demerit points mentioned in schedule 1, part 1.2, column 6 for the offence if the offence is mentioned in any of the following provisions of the [Australian Road Rules](#):
- (i) rule 20 (Obeying the speed-limit);
 - (ii) rule 264 (Wearing of seatbelts by drivers);
 - (iii) rule 265 (3) (Wearing of seatbelts by passengers 16 years old or older);
 - (iv) rule 266 (Wearing of seatbelts by passengers under 16 years old);
 - (v) rule 268 (4A) (How persons must travel in or on a motor vehicle);
 - (vi) rule 268 (4B);
 - (vii) rule 270 (1) (a) (Wearing motor bike helmets);
 - (viii) rule 270 (1) (b);
 - (ix) rule 300 (1) (Use of mobile phones); or
