1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Road Transport Legislation Amendment Regulation 2017 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the commencement of the *Road Transport Reform (Light Rail) Legislation Amendment Act 2017*, section 3.

This regulation amends the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2005* and the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000*.

8 Section 38M

substitute

38M Personal mobility device use alongside more than 1 other person using personal mobility device

- (1) A person must not use a personal mobility device on a road or crossing alongside 2 or more other people using personal mobility devices.

Maximum penalty: 20 penalty units.

- (2) Subsection (1) does not apply if the person is overtaking the other people.

Note The defendant has an evidential burden in relation to the matters mentioned in subsection (2) (see [Criminal Code](#), s 58).

- (3) In this section:

crossing—see section 38L (2).

line of traffic—see the [Australian Road Rules](#), dictionary.

marked lane—see the [Australian Road Rules](#), dictionary.

road does not include a road-related area, but includes a bicycle path, footpath, shared path and a shoulder of a road.
