Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Building (General) Amendment* Regulation 2020 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 April 2021.

Legislation amended

This regulation amends the Building (General) Regulation 2008.

4 New section 33A

insert

33A Stage inspections for dwellings and buildings containing dwellings—Act, s 44 (1A)

A certifier must give the construction occupations registrar the following information as soon as practicable (but in any case within 2 working days) after inspecting a stage of building work for a dwelling or a building containing a dwelling:

- (a) the block and section number and division for the parcel of land on which the building work is carried out;
- (b) the building approval number for the building work;
- (c) the stage of building work that was inspected;
- (d) whether the certifier is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the building work complies with the Act, section 42.
