Crimes (Surveillance Devices) Amendment Regulation 2022 (No 1)

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Crimes (Surveillance Devices) Amendment Regulation 2022 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Crimes* (Surveillance Devices) Regulation 2017.

4 New section 3 (f)

insert

(f) the *Surveillance Devices Act 2016* (SA), except to the extent that it provides for a surveillance device (emergency) authority to be granted in relation to a serious drug offence.

Note A surveillance device (emergency) authority would otherwise be a corresponding emergency authorisation (see Act, dict, def *corresponding emergency authorisation*).

5 New section 3 (2)

insert

(2) In this section:

serious drug offence—see the Surveillance Devices Act 2016 (SA), section 3.

surveillance device (emergency) authority—see the Surveillance Devices Act 2016 (SA), section 3.
