1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance) Amendment Regulation 2026 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 July 2026.

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance) Regulation 2016*.
