Motor Traffic (Amendment) Bill 1999

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the Motor Traffic Act 1936

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act 1999.

5 2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Motor Traffic Act 1936.1

- 4. Insertion
- After section 164B of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:

"164BA. Seatbelts for each passenger

- "(1) A person shall not drive a motor vehicle on a public street if the vehicle has more passengers than there are seating positions that—
 - (a) are fitted with a seatbelt or child restraint; and
 - (b) are available for passengers.

Penalty: 20 penalty units.

- "(2) This section does not apply to the driver of a motor vehicle that is not required under this Act to be fitted with seatbelts.".
- 5. Wearing of seatbelts by passengers in prescribed vehicles

Section 164C of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph:

'(b) a passenger to whom this section applies is occupying a position in the vehicle that is not equipped with a seatbelt and another unoccupied position in the vehicle is equipped with a seatbelt;".
