## **Appropriation Bill 2008-2009 (No 3)**

---

### **A Bill for**

An Act to appropriate additional money for the purposes of the Territory for the financial year that began on 1 July 2008

---

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1     **1           Name of Act**

2           This Act is the *Appropriation Act 2008-2009 (No 3)*.

3     **2           Commencement**

4           This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

5           *Note*     The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on  
6                      the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

7     **3           Notes**

8           A note included in this Act is explanatory and is not part of this Act.

9           *Note*     See the Legislation Act, s 127 (1), (4) and (5) for the legal status of  
10                     notes.

11    **4           Purposes**

12           This Act is made for the purposes of—

13           (a) the Self-Government Act, section 57 and section 58; and

14           (b) the Financial Management Act, section 6 and section 8.

15    **5           Definitions—Act**

16           In this Act:

17           *Financial Management Act* means the *Financial Management*  
18           *Act 1996*.

19           *financial year* means the year that began on 1 July 2008.

20    **6           Terms used in Financial Management Act**

21           A term used in the Financial Management Act has the same  
22           meaning in this Act.

1     **7           Additional appropriations of \$12 761 000**

- 2           (1) The amount of \$251 000 is appropriated to the Legislative  
3           Assembly Secretariat for an additional capital injection in the  
4           financial year for the appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1,  
5           column 2 for that department.
- 6           (2) The amount of \$800 000 is appropriated to the Chief Minister's  
7           Department for an additional capital injection in the financial year  
8           for the appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 for that  
9           department.
- 10          (3) The amount of \$890 000 is appropriated to ACT Health for an  
11          additional capital injection in the financial year for the appropriation  
12          unit mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 for that department.
- 13          (4) The amount of \$1 610 000 is appropriated to the Department of  
14          Territory and Municipal Services for an additional capital injection  
15          in the financial year for the appropriation unit mentioned in  
16          schedule 1, column 2 for that department.
- 17          (5) The amount of \$100 000 is appropriated to the ACT Planning and  
18          Land Authority for an additional capital injection in the financial  
19          year for the appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1, column 2  
20          for that department.
- 21          (6) The amount of \$1 185 000 is appropriated to the Department of  
22          Disability, Housing and Community Services for an additional  
23          capital injection in the financial year for the appropriation unit  
24          mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 for that department.
- 25          (7) The amount of \$2 500 000 is appropriated to Housing ACT for an  
26          additional capital injection in the financial year for the appropriation  
27          unit mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 for that department.
- 28          (8) The amount of \$680 000 is appropriated to the Department of  
29          Justice and Community Safety for an additional capital injection in  
30          the financial year for the appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1,  
31          column 2 for that department.

- 1           (9) The amount of \$1 800 000 is appropriated to the Department of  
2           Education and Training for an additional capital injection in the  
3           financial year for the appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1,  
4           column 2 for that department.
- 5           (10) The amount of \$2 670 000 is appropriated to the Canberra Institute  
6           of Technology for an additional capital injection in the financial  
7           year for the appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1, column 2  
8           for that department.
- 9           (11) The amount of \$160 000 is appropriated to the Exhibition Park  
10          Corporation for an additional capital injection in the financial year  
11          for the appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 for that  
12          department.
- 13          (12) The amount of \$115 000 is appropriated to the Cultural Facilities  
14          Corporation for an additional capital injection in the financial year  
15          for the appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 for that  
16          department.

17       **8           Appropriation units and output classes**

- 18           (1) A group of outputs mentioned in schedule 1, column 3 is identified  
19           as a class of outputs for the Financial Management Act.
- 20           (2) An appropriation unit mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 consists of  
21           the classes of outputs, or the group of output classes, mentioned in  
22           column 3 for the appropriation unit.

23       **9           Net appropriation for capital injection**

24           For the Financial Management Act, section 9A, it is stated that the  
25           appropriations for additional capital injection mentioned in  
26           section 7 are for, or partly for, the net cost of purchasing or  
27           developing assets.
