#### A Bill for

An Act to amend the Emergencies Act 2004

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

2		This Act is the Emergencies (Bushfire Warnings) Amendment Act 2009.

5		This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

15		fire danger index means an index worked out—
16		(a) using the McArthur Mk 5 Forest Fire Danger Meter; or

2		(1)	The Minister must issue a fire danger index in the ACT for—	
3			(a) each day during the bushfire season; and	
4 5			(b) any day outside the bushfire season for which the fire danger index is 25 or higher.	
6 7 8		(2)	If the fire danger index issued under subsection (1) for a day is 25 or higher, the Minister must also issue any later increase in the index for the day.	
9 10 11 12		(3)	If the fire danger index issued under subsection (1) (a) for a day is lower than 25 but the index increases to 25 or higher during the day, the Minister must also issue the increase and any later increase in the index for the day.

14 15		(1)	If the fire danger index is 25 or higher, the Minister must also issue a bushfire warning with the index.	
16 17		(2)	A bushfire warning issued under subsection (1) must include the following:	
18			(a) the fire danger index;	
19 20			(b) the bushfire activity category mentioned in table 85C, column 3 for the fire danger index;	
21 22			(c) the bushfire warning level mentioned in table 85C, column 4 for the fire danger index;	
23			(d) the locations or suburbs to which the warning applies;	
24 25 26 27			(e) if the fire danger index is 49 or lower—a recommendation that people consider their readiness for a bushfire and quickly decide whether to stay and defend their location or whether to evacuate;	

1	(f)	if the fire danger index is 50 or higher—a recommendation
2		that, if people have not prepared their location for a bushfire
3		and do not have the experience to stay and defend their
4		location, they should evacuate before a fire starts;
5	(g)	a statement to the effect that the conditions may cause fires to
6		develop very quickly into very large, uncontrollable bushfires
7		that may lead to loss of life and property;
8	(h)	information about where people should go if they decide to
9		evacuate;

22 23			(a) the fire danger index and corresponding bushfire activity categories and bushfire warning levels; and
24			(b) the potential consequences of different fire danger indexes; and
25 26			(c) the action to be undertaken by members of the public when a bushfire warning is issued.
