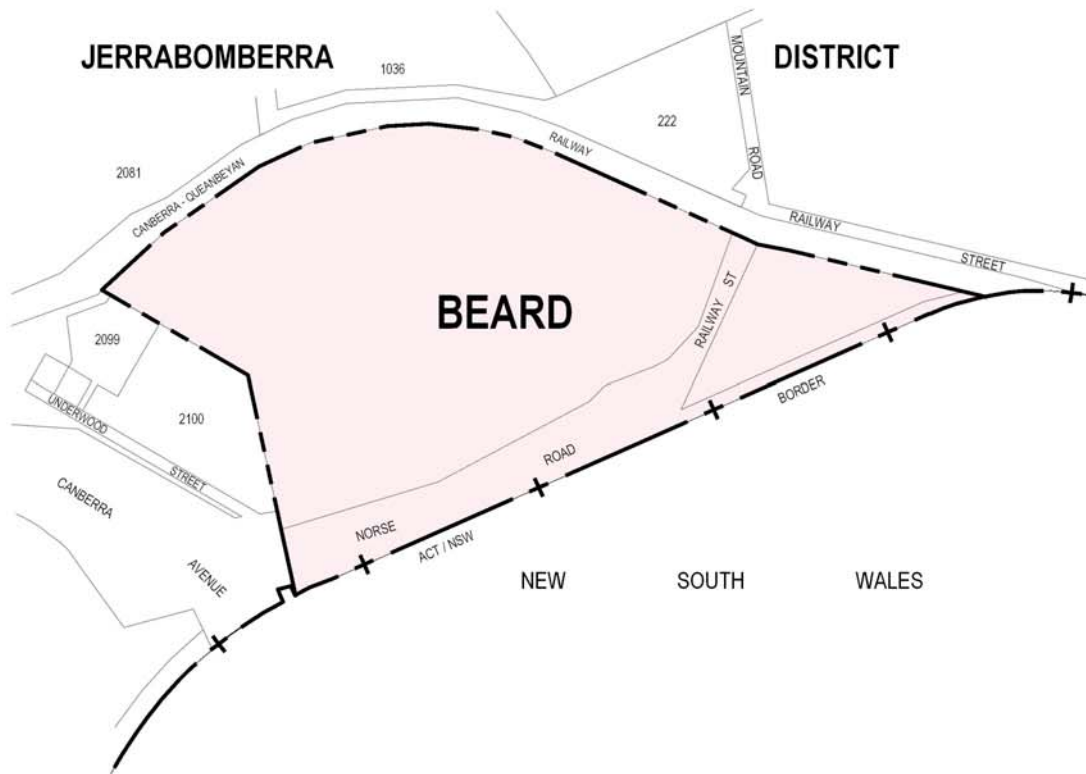

DIVISION NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
BEARD	Timothy Beard (1762-1846)	Timothy Beard, an ex-convict, was the first person to have a property 'Quinbean' in the vicinity of this division. During the mid 1820s he pastured cattle on the site. Records indicate he actually 'sat' on this land for Sheriff Thomas Macquoid.

The place naming theme for this division is *Australian geological resources*.
