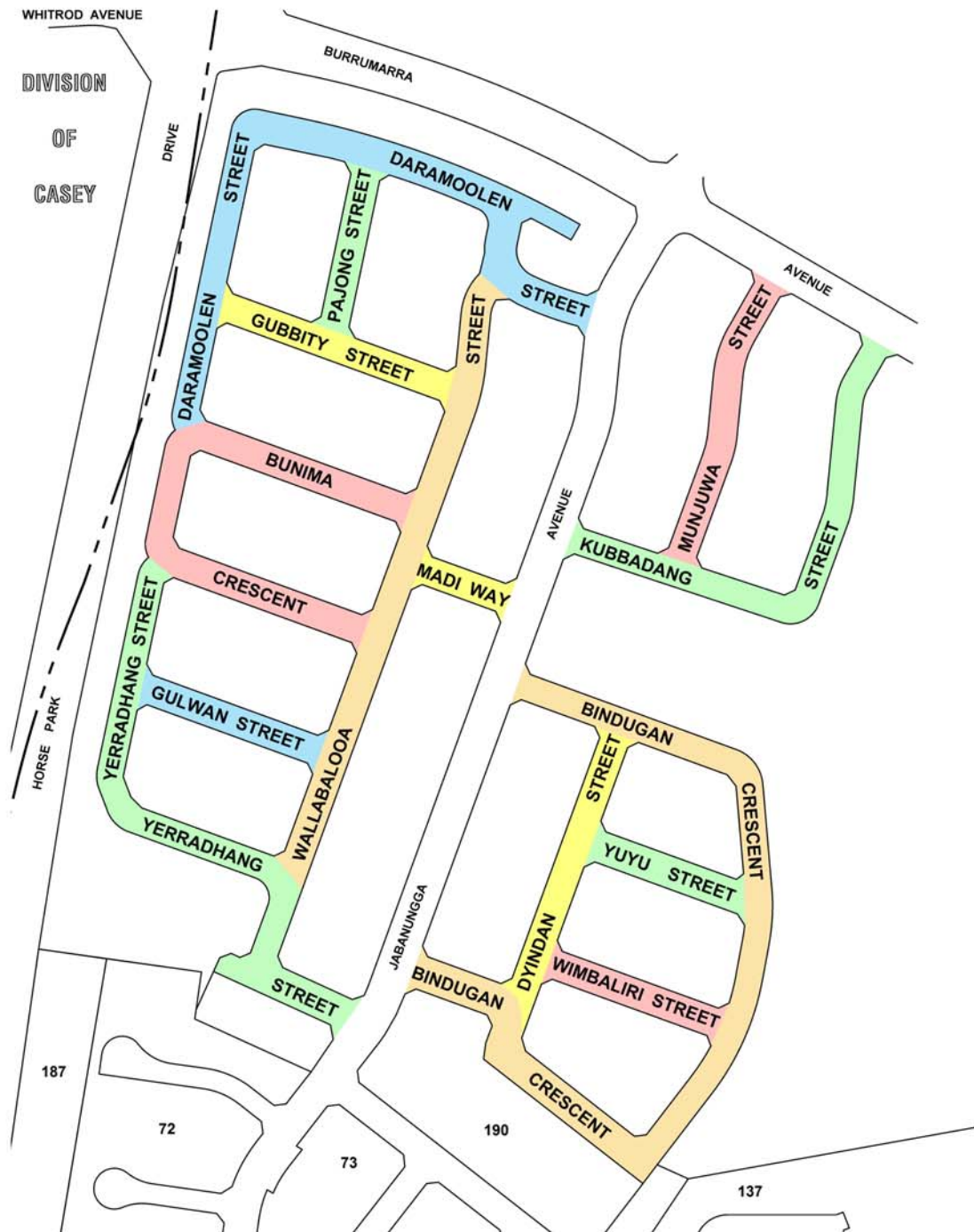

<b>Madi Way</b>	Ngunnawal word	Meaning: very
