EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OUTLINE

The purpose of this Bill is to restore the right of citizens to apply to the Supreme Court to review decisions made by the government under the Land (Planning & Environment) Act 1991, and the Heritage Objects Act 1991.

NOTES ON CLAUSES

Clauses 1, 2 and 3.

These clauses are the formal provisions that specify the short title of the Bill; provide for commencement, and identify the Principal Act.

Clause 4

This clause amends section 3 of the Principal Act to extend the definition of 'a person aggrieved' to include a person who considers that a government decision made under the Land (Planning & Environment) Act 1991, and the Heritage Objects Act 1991 is contrary to law.
