EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

**OUTLINE**

The purpose of this Bill is to restore the right of citizens to apply to the Supreme Court to review decisions made by the government under the *Land (Planning & Environment) Act 1991*, and the *Heritage Objects Act 1991*.

**NOTES ON CLAUSES**

Clauses 1, 2 and 3.

These clauses are the formal provisions that specify the short title of the Bill; provide for commencement, and identify the Principal Act.

Clause 4

This clause amends section 3 of the Principal Act to extend the definition of 'a person aggrieved' to include a person who considers that a government decision made under the *Land (Planning & Environment) Act 1991*, and the *Heritage Objects Act 1991* is contrary to law.
